Characteristics:

- **1.** Paper colors: pastel canary, uncoated type.
- 2. Paper weight: 70 g/m².
- 3. Paper type: 100 % virgin paper.
- **4.** Paper bleaching : **ECF** type.
- **5.** Backsheet: printed white paper 70 g/m² Paper is 100% virgin Paper bleaching is **ECF** type.
- **6.** Environmental labelling of this product: 100% PEFC certification for the paper and the backsheet

Canary Post-it® paper is manufactured with 100% PEFC certified pulp then Specifications require 70% minimum of pulp certified to obtain a 100% PEFC certification.

PEFC stands for **P**rogram for the **E**ndorsement of **F**orest **C**ertification schemes **PEFC** certification is a transparent system of forest inspection plus a means of tracking timber and paper, from harvested tree through to the finished product

ECF stands for Elemental Chlorine Free meaning that no Cl₂ is used for bleaching the pulp (Cl₂ is a very strong oxidizing agent which has negative effects on the environment).
